City of Norton

James Moreau, City Administrator, Abigail Horn, City Attorney and Jeff Wolf, City Code were in to visit with the commission on the property known as Norton Commons. The City of Norton is interested in forming a task force to address issues with the property that included environmental and rodent concerns. The City would like to have a member of the Norton County Commissioners serve on the task force. Commissioner Matchett was appointed to the task force to represent the county.

KLPG

Neighborhood Revitalization
