## Notice of Places and Dates of Registration For General Election

In compliance with the provisions of K.S.A. 25-2310, notice is hereby given that the voters of NORTON COUNTY, Kansas may register to vote at the following places during regular office hours: Norton County Clerk's Office; Norton County Health Department and on-line with the Kansas Secretary of State web-site.

At 5:00 PM on the 15<sup>th</sup> day of October, 2024, the books for registration of voters will close and will remain closed until the 6<sup>th</sup> day of November, 2024.

A citizen of the United States who is 18 years of age or older, or will have attained the age of 18 years at the next election, must register before he or she can vote. Registration closes 21 days prior to every election.

When a registered voter changes residence from one precinct to another precinct, such voter must re-register in order to be eligible to vote. Any person may apply in person or by mail to the County election officer to be registered. Application form shall be provided by the county election officer upon request by the applicant. Such application shall be signed by the applicant under penalty of perjury.
